HANNA'S STORY

(23-years-old, non-binary [she/her/they/them], pansexual)

There was this one night, this one party, at my house. And I wasn't really in a party mood. It was a huge sesh, there was like 40 people, everyone was topless, everyone was on 10 tabs of acid and 40 Xanax, and just wild. And I was like... I had a good time, I had a drink, I had a Valium at 11:30 and went to bed. And this guy comes into my room at 4:00am saying Hanna, we can't turn the fire alarms off. And I'm obviously vallied up, and like... coming down off drinking, so I'm wavy.



I go into the living room and wow, it's a shit show. It's really cigarette smokey, maybe that's why the alarms have gone off. It's so stressful, its panic-inducing stressful. And I'm in the middle of dissertation, and not a happy person right now. Eventually we decide the only logical thing to do is to bash the alarms out of the ceiling, so I have to go around the house and watch these guys bash them with pans and stuff. And it was just very traumatising. And then it stopped, the music came back on, and I went into my room and sat on my bed like... oh my god. I don't feel okay right now.



[Best friend] had gone, and I was like fuck, I can't stay here, I'm freaking out. Where can I go? The only person I felt comfortable going to was [ex-boyfriend], because he'd sorted me out in panic attacks before. He was very good at it. So I called him, he was awake, and he was like, yeah come over. I got into his place, he calmed me down and we got into bed. And he was just like hugging me. And I think he was trying to kiss me and stuff, but I was just like whatever, just like... I'm here and I'm safe. So I went to sleep. Yeah, and then basically, I don't know what time it was... it was kind of light outside... I woke up because his hand was down my pants.





88% incidents involved alcohol 55% involved alcohol only






36% incidents involved alcohol and drugs

Around a third: combination of alcohol and cannabis








Which of these substances were given to you by the person(s) who took advantage of you?

NEVER HAVE I EVER WALKED HOME ALONE



of Durham University students stay safe by choosing not to walk home alone after a night out

Based on a survey of 1,093 Durham University students in December 2014

Over two thirds of incidents occurred **in private spaces**





74% knew other people nearby at the time of the incident



2019

70% knew the perpetrator

12% : knew perpetrator was attracted to them

9% : in a relationship with perpetrator







To what extent can you recall the events of the incident?




Did you report the incident to the police?

AUSTIN'S STORY

- (30-years-old, cis-male [he/him], heterosexual)
- I have one more weed and sex story. This woman texted me on Tinder, blah blah blah, want to come over tonight, and I was like okay, sure. Why not? And I looked at her pictures and was like, hmm, okay she's 40, a little old... but in the photos she looked like a pervert, so it was okay. I decided to buy two bottles of wine, because I had a feeling... I'd need it [laughs]. So, I drove over, she opened the door, and there she was, a 40-year-old woman, so fucking fat. She was really fucked up, oh my god. And I went inside the flat, and I was like, why I am doing this? I was so close to saying goodbye and going home.



Interviewer: But you decided to stay?

Austin: Yeah. Because I was horny. I raped her, literally. Well... not so much rape, because she liked it.

Interviewer: What made you think she liked it?

Austin: Well she was crazy, totally mental. She was fucked up. I got so drunk because, you know, she wasn't my standard. And then, thank god, she had some weed. And I was like, okay, I'll give it a try, I'm not a bad person. We had weed, we had wine, she's a woman, whatever. I had a condom on, thank god, because I was so stoned and so drunk. And I felt nothing. Nothing. Like when you throw a sausage down a tunnel. And then, oh my god, I fucked her face so hard, it was brutal. And then I fisted her, and I choked her... And she squirted, at the end. It was a winwin situation, because I never had sex with a girl that could squirt, and I never fisted a girl, it was a win-win situation for me [laughs].


