
Six people have died at Time Warp Argentina in Buenos Aires. 16/04/2016 Originally reported by the *BBC* Saturday, the death toll has since risen to six, according to the *Buenos Aires Herald*. All six deaths, and four critical hospitalizations, are suspected to from drug overdoses, and the Coast Guard and the Unit Against Drug-Trafficking are currently investigation. There were also reports from attendees of overcrowding and poor ventilation with one stating "it was too not and there were too many people," and another adding "we couldn't breathe."

## Policy framework on dance events

2009: starting point "Dance events are drug free"

#### 2015: final policy framework:

"Drugs should not be part of dance events. We strive for drug-free parties"

"We are committed to reducing (health) risks associated with the use of recreational drugs at dance parties."

2016: rules for clubs hosting dance events

- Agree on responsibilities

#### Repression





At this event, we have a zero-tolerance drugs policy. You can voluntarily lispose of your drugs here, vithout any consequences. After this point, you'll be handed over to the police if drugs are found.



### Party organizers responsibilities (1)



- Security search at the entrance (by private security companies)
- Surveillance at the event site

No drugs allowed

- Drugs are confiscated
- Person will be **removed** from the event site
- And handed over to the police (if the amount of drugs is prosecutable)

## **X** Party organizers responsibilities (2)

### Harm reduction

Set up **professional First Aid** at the event site (including observation room); Advanced Live Support

Consult First Aid officers before security removes an (apparently) intoxicated person from the event site



## Party organizers responsibilities (3)

- Establish a "chill-out" (a place to rest and cool down)
- Monitor temperature and humidity
- Provide free drinking water
- Raise awareness /inform visitors



## **S** Five years later

- More cooperation among stakeholders
- Direct feedback on inspections -> organisers are able to learn
- Many party organisers have joined Celebrate Safe campaign
- Inspection team is overall satisfied with the results
- Implementing and updating the policy remains continuing effort
- Drugs becoming more mainstream ...
- Still relatively little incidents, as a result of....?
